

### Class 1 Trip to Hunstanton Beach and 'The Sea Life Sanctuary'

Dear Parents,

Next term, our Topic is 'Ahoy there' so we have decided to take the children to Hunstanton Beach in Norfolk **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2017**. We will spend the morning on the beach, building sandcastles, looking in rockpools etc. and having a picnic lunch. Then we will visit Hunstanton Sea Life Sanctuary in the afternoon.

In order for us to make the most of the day, we would like the children to arrive at school at 7.30am. The coach will set off at 7.45am, arriving in Hunstanton at approximately 10.45am (we will be stopping at Peterborough services for a short break). The coach will leave Hunstanton at 3.30pm and arrive back at school by approximately 6.45pm (we will confirm this via the school text message service).

The children can wear non-school uniform leggings/trousers but we would like them to wear school uniform t-shirts, jumpers or cardigans. On this occasion it would also be useful for the children to have their own small rucksack style bag to carry their own lunch, coat etc.

The children will need:

- a packed lunch with an extra snack spare drinks/water bottle (no glass, canned or fizzy drinks please)
- a sunhat
- sun tan lotion (or preferably apply all-day protection sun cream before they come to school)
- a waterproof coat
- to take travel sickness medication before coming to school (please also hand these in to Mrs Davies if needed for the return journey)
- to wear sensible shoes that cover the whole foot
- to bring an inhaler/ other medication (if required) in a named clear plastic bag and hand this to a teacher on arrival in the morning
- spending money in a named purse (maximum £5.00)
- a small bucket and spade (if you have one)

The actual cost of the trip works out at £25 per child; however, thanks to a subsidy from school funds we are able to offer a reduced cost of £15 per child which covers coach travel and entrance to the Sea Life Sanctuary.
