Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will know, our current topic in Class 2 this term is 'Castles'. As part of the topic, I thought that it would be fantastic for the children to be given the opportunity to explore a Stone Keep castle and therefore have organised a trip to Warwick Castle.

The trip will take place on Monday 17th October 2016. We will leave school promptly at 9.00am and I would therefore be grateful if your child could be in the classroom by 8.45am to allow us to leave school on time. The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposal bag and are required to wear full school uniform on this day. They will need a coat as well, but no book bags will be necessary.

If you wish for your child to go on the trip the cost will be £14.50 and will need to be paid to school by Wednesday 28th September 2016.

In addition to the school trip, Class 2 will be taking part in a medieval day on 10th October 2016. For this day, it would be fantastic if your child could come to school in a medieval themed fancy dress, i.e. a king, queen, knight. If you do find it tricky to find an outfit, please come and see an adult in Class 2 as there are outfits in school that you can use. During the afternoon on the 10th October 2016, we will be holding a 'Parent Share' session at 2.30pm. This will be an opportunity for the children to present their work on castles to you and perform a medieval dance. This will also be a chance for you to look through their topic and topic related literacy work. Please note that younger children are also welcome.
