## Class 1 Trip to Stanwick Lakes - Tuesday 2nd July

Next term, our Topic is 'Ahoy There!' so we have decided to take the children to Stanwick Lakes on a pirate adventure. We will be exploring the different environments of the 'island' we land on. This will be done through pond dipping, an adventure trail with waterplay and discovering the nature reserve and wildlife. As part of our geography unit, we will also be conducting a survey to see why it makes a good place for families to visit.

The children will need to arrive at school at 8:45am, as normal, and the coach will set off at 9.00. The coach will leave Stanwick Lakes at 2.30pm and arrive back at school for 3.15pm.

The children will not need to wear school uniform, but they will need to wear sensible, weather appropriate clothes that will enable them to be active. These should be clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. This includes trainers (no crocs) and leggings/trousers/shorts/sunhat.

They will also need...

- a packed lunch and drink in a small rucksack (no glass, canned or fizzy drinks please)
- a waterproof coat
- sun cream (if weather appropriate)
- a small towel to dry their feet
- to take travel sickness medication before coming to school (please also hand these to Miss Churms if needed for the return journey)

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.00 per child. If your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, only consent via the app is required. Please be aware if we don't get enough contributions then the trip will not be viable.
