Class 3 visit to Flore Farm Park

This term in Class 3 our topic is 'Local Explorers'. The children will be developing their understanding of land use in the local area and learning to use Ordinance Survey maps and symbols. To support this growing knowledge, they will plan a walking route to visit **Flore Farm Park on Monday 29th April 2023.**

On the walk, children will engage in fieldwork activities based on their geographical enquiries. At the farm the children will see agricultural land use and have the opportunity to enjoy feeding the animals.

There is no cost for the trip as the farm have kindly given us free use of their facilities. However, should your child wish to enjoy an ice cream at the café, they may bring spending money (£2.50 recommended), to be given to an adult on the day.

Your child may wear their own comfortable, weather appropriate clothes (e.g. leggings/jogging bottoms and trainers/wellies) for walking to and from the farm. Please avoid shorts because of stinging nettles. They will need a sun hat, sun cream, a waterproof coat and packed lunch to eat at the farm. All of their belongings will need to be carried by the child in a suitable rucksack.

We will leave school at 10.00am and return to school for 2.30pm so children can be dropped off and collected at normal times. Please be assured that all appropriate control and safety measures have been considered to minimise any foreseen risks as all school trips go through a very thorough planning process, which involves guidance and approval from a third-party risk assessment company.
