Re: Year 5 trip to Tudor World

As part of our theme topic during the summer term, we would like to take the children to visit **Tudor World** on **Thursday 16th May 2024**. The visit will give the children a great insight into their learning about the Tudor times, the day will involve a carousel of interactive workshops covering the museum, theatre area and workshop room on different aspects of the Tudors including artefact handling. The day finishes with a tour of Stratford upon Avon with 'significant person' William Shakespeare or Anne Shakespeare.

Details of the day

- Children will need to arrive at school at normal time dressed in **full school uniform**.
- The coach will leave **promptly at 9am**.
- They will need to bring a packed lunch with a refillable drink in a named plastic bag. No glass bottles or fizzy drinks please.
- We anticipate that the coach will arrive back at school for the children to be picked up at around **4 / 4.15pm**. We will keep you updated on the arrival time via Schoolcomms.
- The children will be allowed to bring a maximum of £5 each to spend in the gift shop. They will be responsible for their own money. As such, they may wish to bring a small bag with them to carry their money and water bottle in.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £25, this covers the coach cost and the workshops. If your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, only consent via the app is required. Please be aware if we don't get enough contributions then the trip will not be viable.
